Teaching-Learning Environment



A brief Analysis of the above Feedback received from the students over different facilities and aspects of the Institution and Actions to be taken:

- 1. On Academic facilities:** Although most of the students are satisfied with the existing 'Academic facilities' of the college, a few more initiatives can be taken by introducing more ICT-enabled classroom and Laboratory-infrastructures.
- 2. On Teachers' Performance:** Depending upon the 'Feedback' received from the students, IQAC suggests that the Teachers should be more focused in preparing their 'Teaching Plan' and delivering their lectures more effectively.
- 3. On Learning Opportunities:** The Learning Opportunities are good but still there are certain areas where it can be further improved.
- 4. On Evaluation Process:** The Evaluation Process is simultaneous run by the College and the affiliating University (WBSU) throughout the year. External/Internals Tests or Examinations are taken in both 'Online/Offline' mode for the sake of students. And the corresponding 'Feedback' is satisfactory.
- 5. On Co-curricular Activities:** Although the Students are satisfied with the existing 'Co-curricular Activities' such as Games & Sports, NSS-Programmes, Cultural events, Annual function, etc, the college authority is suggested to introduce a good playground with multiple sports-facilities.
- 6. On Computer/Soft-skill Facilities:** The IQAC suggests that more Computers need to be purchased and skill-enhancement programme relating to different Computer Applications may be introduced.
- 7. On Learning to Grow Facilities:** The college authority is suggested to introduce more learning facilities for the betterment of the students.
- 8. On Teaching-Learning Environment:** The overall Teaching-Learning environment is good. Regular classes are held and students are guided effectively to cope up with the newly-introduced CBCS-curriculum.
- 9. Remarks:** Different Cells and sub-committees of the college are suggested to work on further improvement in the curricular and co-curricular activities for the students from the next sessions.
