

A brief Analysis of the above Feedback received from the students over different facilities and aspects of the Institution and Actions to be taken: (Total students = 462)

(Though the session: 2020-2021 was a Covid-pandemic session where most of the time the college-campus was remain closed and the classes and the examinations were taken through 'online-mode', yet the students put their valuable suggestions for the betterment of the teaching-learning process.)

- 1. On Academic facilities:** Students have suggested to increase the no. of class-rooms and laboratory facilities.
- 2. On Teachers' Performance:** As per their suggestions, teachers should be more focused in preparing their 'Teaching Plan' and completing the syllabus in due time.
- 3. On Learning Opportunities:** The Learning Opportunities are good but there are certain areas where it can be further improvement must be done.
- 4. On Evaluation Process:** Most of the students are satisfied with the evaluation process which is simultaneous run by the College and the affiliating University (WBSU) throughout the year. Examinations are taken in both 'Online/Offline' mode for the sake of students.
