A well-concerted contribution of the academic journals of both the colleges, publishing of Students' Magazines / webzines, departmental e-journals etc.

 5. Library facilities: Resources of both the colleges can be shared, modus operandi of which will be settled jointly by the Library departments of the colleges.
- 6. It is agreed by both the colleges that expenses to be incurred in connection with different programmes will be borne by the respective college of the participants/candidates.
- Both the colleges have agreed that if additional assistance is required in that event Principal of both colleges will settle mutually after discussions.
- 8. That in respect of the abovementioned programmes and/or activities only Principals of both the colleges will take all responsibilities regarding selection of candidate(s)/participant(s) and other matters of the said purpose.
- If any disputes arise in respect of this MOU in that case Principal of both the colleges will discuss and settle the matter amicably.
- . Both the colleges have entered into this Memorandum of Understanding for the period of two years in first phase.
