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UG ONLINE ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA– 2023-24

**FOR FIRST SEMESTER of U.G. COURSES UNDER NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY, 2020
IN THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-24**

The College offers **4-year Undergraduate Programs (Honours/Honours with Research)** and **3-year Multidisciplinary Undergraduate Programs** in Arts, Commerce and Science under Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUG) based on National Education Policy, 2020 during the academic session 2023-24 under West Bengal State University. The duration of the UG Programme (Honours/Honours with research) is 4 years or 8 semesters and UG Programme (Multidisciplinary) 3 years or 6 semesters. Students who desire to undergo a 3-year UG Programme will be allowed to exit after completion of the 3rd year. Students may be permitted to take a break from the study during the period of study but the total duration for completing the Programme shall not exceed 7 years. The duration for Multidisciplinary UG Programme is 3 years, provided the student has completed all requirements to become eligible for appearing the University Examinations as per rules and syllabus pattern of West Bengal State University to which the College is affiliated.

Eligibility Criteria for:

- Admission in First Semester of the **Eight Semester (4-year) Undergraduate Programs in B.A./B.Sc. /B.Com.(Honours/Honours with Research)** under NEP and
 - Admission in First Semester of the **Six Semester (3-year) Multidisciplinary Undergraduate Programs in B.A./B.Sc. /B.Com.** under NEP
1. A candidate, who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or its equivalent from the All-India Boards / Councils or State Boards/ Councils including Open Schools and Vocational Studies, AND
 2. Passed in English having full marks of 100 (as per University Rules), AND
 3. Passed the previous qualifying examination on or after 2020 for Honours/Honours Research.
 4. Passed the previous qualifying examination on or after 2017 for Multidisciplinary programme.
 5. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the **4-year Honours Course**, aggregate marks shall be calculated by **adding the marks of top four subjects** in order of marks secured by a candidate. However, marks in **compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account** for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject “Environmental Science” is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.
 6. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the **3-year Multidisciplinary UG programme of study**, aggregate marks shall be calculated by **adding the marks of top four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate**. However, **marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account** for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject “Environmental Science” is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

N.B.: Admission to the Under Graduate Courses is strictly based on the Merit. All the process of UG Admission is strictly guided by the rules and regulations of West Bengal Higher Education Council’s, Higher Education Department, Govt. of WB and West Bengal State University.

Choice of Courses:

(A) 4-year UG (Honours/Honours with Research) Course of Studies: Candidates will have to choose a **single major discipline** and **any two minor disciplines** along with the requisite numbers of AEC, SEC, MDC & VAC along with **internship** as shown in Table 1 & 2. The combination of major and two minor disciplines for the students admitted in 4-year UG (Honours/Honours with research) will be decided by the concerned college.

[Nomenclature of degree will be notified later on communication from UGC.]**

(B) 3-Year Multidisciplinary Undergraduate (UG) programme of study: A candidate is required to choose **any three subjects** from **one or two broad** category of disciplines as offered by the concerned college. He/she will be awarded a 3-year B.A./B.Sc./B. Com. in a particular discipline provided that **at least two** out of the three subjects chosen by him/her falls in that particular category.

Broad Category of Disciplines

- (i) **Physical Sciences:** Chemistry, Physics, Electronics.
- (ii) **Life Sciences:** Bio-chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Physiology, Molecular Biology, Microbiology, Food & nutrition, Fishery Science, Bio-technology, Anthropology, Environmental Science.
- (iii) **Mathematical and Computer Sciences:** Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Science, Computer Application.
- (iv) **Humanities:** Film Studies, Physical Education, Human Rights, Women Studies, Human Development, Philosophy, Journalism & Mass Communication, NCC, Music, English, Bengali, Hindi, Urdu, Sanskrit, Arabic, Defence Studies.
- (v) **Social Sciences:** Political Science, History, Economics, Education, Psychology, Sociology, Geography, Travel & Tourism Management, Advertising & Sales Promotion.
- (vi) **Commerce & Management:** Accounting, Finance, Business Economics, Management and all other allied subjects.

Groups of Subjects:

Gr. I: Physics, Zoology, Education, Film Studies, Physical Education, Human Rights, Women Studies, NCC

Gr. II: Mathematics, Human Development, History, Environmental Science

Note:

(A). For the 4-year UG Programme with Honours, a candidate is required to choose his/her Major in a discipline and two other disciplines for Minor courses, from among Group-I to Group-VIII as above by taking not more than one discipline from any of the groups mentioned above.

(B). For the 3-year Multidisciplinary Course of Studies, a candidate is required to choose any three Core subjects from among the broad category of disciplines (list 6) as offered by the concerned college. However, the choice of the three subjects will have to be made as stated hereunder:

- For B.Sc. 3-year Multidisciplinary Programme, a candidate is required to choose three Core subjects from among Group I to VIII by taking not more than one subject from the same group and at least two science subjects.
- For the B.A. 3-year Multidisciplinary Course of Studies, a candidate is required to choose three Core subjects from among Group I to VIII by taking not more than one subject from the same group and at least two subjects from Humanities and Social Sciences.
- For B. Com 3-year Multidisciplinary programme three core subjects to be chosen from Commerce and allied discipline maintaining NEP norm.
